## Our New Online Management System - myU3A

A further grant was recently received from BVSC for a similar amount to assist with 2016 Seniors Week, which will take the form of a debate entitled *Youth versus Experience* between members of U3A SC and students from Lumen Christi College. The event will be held on April 6th at Club Sapphire.
